We're coming back to Japan! Through your prayers and God's grace, we have been accepted in 2019 to be the host family at Yamanaka Chalet, a Christian retreat camp near Mt. Fuji. Yamanaka Chalet is operated by SEND International, a worldwide church-planting ministry. After completing our current assignment at KRC in January, we will take a break in Bangkok then start this new one-year assignment in April. A New Challenge & Greater Opportunities

This new assignment fulfills many desires we have had. At Yamanaka Chalet, we will have full charge of all hospitality, management, and maintenance duties. Living onsite will allow us to work side-by-side as a couple in ways that we couldn't at KRC.

More importantly, it will provide us greater time for outreach in the local community for sharing God's word. We have had limited time for outreach in our current assignment due to heavy workload at KRC.

What It Will Take

Budget

Ministry support needs are roughly the same as for 2018. As before, we will dedicate a full year of John's Navy retirement pay to finance this work. Expenses above and beyond that are shown here.

To reach our financial goal, we need to raise \$10,000 by April, <u>plus</u> receive pledges totaling \$1000/month. At our <u>online donor site</u> you can schedule one-time or monthly gifts. SEND will <u>not</u> allow us to return to Japan until all these funds are received or pledged.
