Subject: Re-opening Procedures

West Oahu Christian Church is committed to conducting worship services again with the spiritual, physical and emotional health of our attendees in mind. In light of the recent Covid-19 pandemic and the guidelines put forth by our Federal, State and County governments, we will open our worship services to the public beginning on 5/31/20 following these guidelines:

- A) All attendees must wash or sanitize their hands prior to entering the sanctuary. Pump sanitizer dispensers will be available at the entrance.
- B) All attendees (with the exception of those on stage) will be required to wear masks during the service. Masks will be made available for those who did not bring one.
- C) Social distancing will be observed in the sanctuary. Members of the same families are allowed to sit together. There must be approximately 6 feet between individuals or family groups.
- D) Offerings will not be collected during the service. A box will be placed at the entrance where congregants may deposit their tithes and offerings.
- E) Attendees will be asked to leave the sanctuary when the service ends so the chairs and furniture can be cleaned/sanitized.

These guidelines will be in place until such time the government authorities relaxes the requirements. We thank everyone for their patience and understanding during this season, as we do not expect these rules to last indefinitely. We wish to be considerate of each other but our Lord has not designed us to live our lives in fear of physical contact with one another. We pray that God hastens the day when we can worship our Lord with one another free of this current virus.
