(8) We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about the <u>hardships</u> we <u>suffered</u> in the province of Asia. We were under <u>great pressure</u>, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we <u>despaired even of life</u>. (9) Indeed, in our hearts we felt the <u>sentence of death</u>. But this happened that we might *not rely on ourselves*, but on God who raises the dead. (10) *He has delivered us* from such a deadly peril, and *he will deliver us*. On him we have *set our hope* that he will *continue to deliver us*, (11) as you **help us by your prayers**. Then many will **give thanks** for the gracious favor granted us in answer to the **prayers of many**.

<u>Social interaction tanked</u>. <u>Economy tanked</u>, <u>Businesses tanked</u>, <u>movies</u> and <u>sports</u> tanked, <u>Church attendance</u> tanked, <u>school attendance</u> tanked. <u>Mental</u> <u>Health</u> tanked. (besides TP and facemask producers)

But we are a people who give thanks. Not because of circumstances, but because the Lord Jesus overcomes the world. Thanksgiving is a great time to remind ourselves that we will have trouble in this world, but ...

## Scripture Reading

#### **Exegesis:**

Context

- Riot in Ephesus (Acts 19).
- Demetrius made silver idols of the goddess Artemis, \$ for craftsmen. Didn't like the message of Christ. Stirred up a riot.
- Paul and his companions were in great danger!
- God's deliverance through the danger prompted tremendous thanksgiving

How did Paul describe their despair? - FAR Beyond their endurance. How response did life tanking for them produce? – Faith What was the result in others? - Thanksgiving!

## When Life Tanks, We Give Thanks...

#### **Pilgrims' Example**

Pilgrims were very strong followers of Christ. Therefore ... Their attitude was, **When Life Tanks, We Give Thanks** (not in those words!)

- death from disease.
- lost 50% of their entire group.

By human measures, their expedition looked a failure.

It ain't worth it. Just give up.

That wasn't their attitude -

They stayed in America, persevered, developed good relationships with native Americans, planted, harvested, gave thanks in the Fall.

I believe that the great losses made the Thanks that much greater.

Like the principle Jesus gave regarding forgiveness...

He who is forgiven much, loves much.

The one forgiven *much* has a perspective of what it's like at the bottom.

Why was Paul so grateful for God's deliverance? Because of the danger!

## The More Life Tanks, the More Our Thanks!

The greater the deliverance, the greater the Thanksgiving.

#### **Enduring Spirit of Thanksgiving**

**Tom Begley** (recorded the events of the 1<sup>st</sup> Thanksgiving)

Venison (deer) and shellfish ... Possibly wild turkey

"Cabbage, carrot, cucumbers, leeks, lettuce, parsnips, pumpkins,"

"There were also a lot of **native** wild plants

Jerusalem artichokes, garlic, cranberries, Concord grapes, walnuts and chestnuts."

I know your mouth is just watering now!

**NO** potatoes, sweet cranberry sauce, Pumpkin pie would have been impossible, as the colony didn't have butter, wheat flour or an oven.

Thanksgiving celebration brought lots of <u>new</u> foods.

#### **Through the Centuries:**
